This is an interesting ride along quiet Cheshire lanes. The highlights of the ride are the Delamere forest, Alderley Edge and the moors above Macclesfield. There are some steep hills. You need to follow the route sheet carefully and are advised to check it out on OS maps 117 & 118 beforehand. Make sure that you have with you spare inner tubes, tyre levers and appropriate tools. You also need waterproofs and take extra food, just in case. Your entry fee covers the cost of refreshments during the ride and tea and biscuits at the end. You should not attempt this ride unless you know you are fit enough.
